- 1. During the period of 10 June 1966 through 08 September 1966. River Patrol Section 512 was embarked in the USS TORTUGA (ISD-26) and conducted operations in the Bessac and Co Chien Rivers and in the rivers of the Rung Set Special Zone of the Republic of Victnen.

- 5. During the period that you have been abourd TORTUGA as part of River Section 512 you have contributed to the accomplishment of the assigned missi in an outstanding manner.
